



Admissions Policy

1. From Cradles to Crayons is a mission-oriented program and does not limit the availability of the program to church members or denominations.
2. Parents must agree that:
 - From Cradles to Crayons has full discretion for the placement of children.
 - They will meet all tuition and other financial obligations, and
 - They will willingly support the center with practical help as needed by the center.
3. Admission of families to From Cradles to Crayons will be based on the date of application and deposit is received by the From Cradles to Crayons office.
4. From Cradles to Crayons does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national, and ethnic origins in the administration of its admissions policies.
5. Religious Training is included in the From Cradles to Crayons center.

Right to Refuse Admission

From Cradles to Crayons reserves the right to refuse admission to any child at any time.

Possible reasons for the refusal of admission include, but are not limited to:

1. Our center is closing due to inclement weather or an act of God
2. The need to maintain compliance with licensing regulations
3. A child deemed too ill to attend
4. A domestic situation that presents a safety risk to the child, employees, or other children enrolled at From Cradles to Crayons if the child were to be present at the center
5. Parent's failure to maintain accurate, up to date records
6. Parent's failure to complete and return required documentation in a timely fashion
7. Parent's failure to pay tuition in a timely manner

*Parents are not reimbursed tuition for days when their child is refused admission to the program. *
